Summary

The editorial team of the report was formed by members of the InterScientia Interdisciplinary Doctoral Student Research Group, operating at the Doctoral School of the University of National Education in Krakow. The circle brings together doctoral students representing various fields of science, and its aim is to promote interdisciplinarity, exchange research experiences and support young scientists in their scientific development and the popularisation of academic achievements. The authors of the report combined their expertise in the social sciences, humanities and natural sciences, which allowed for a multifaceted analysis of the survey results and the formulation of comprehensive conclusions and recommendations.

The aim of the study was to analyse the results of a survey on the scientific activity of doctoral students at the Doctoral School of the University of National Education in Krakow, with particular emphasis on their participation in national and international conferences. The survey covered 111 doctoral students, of whom 59 (53.15%) participated in at least one national conference, while

49 (44.14%) took

The analysis showed an uneven distribution of activity – a small group intensively participating in scientific life plays a dominant role, while a significant part of the respondents is not involved.

The presentations by doctoral students covered a wide range of topics, confirming the interdisciplinary nature of the School, and took various forms, from traditional stationary conferences to remote and hybrid events. A strong local presence (dominated by centres in Krakow and Warsaw) and a significant international dimension were identified (participation in scientific events in 23 countries).

Based on based on the a a number of strategic , including: increasing the availability of financial support, developing mentoring, promoting the internationalisation of research, and systematically monitoring the activities of doctoral students. These conclusions may serve as a basis for further activities supporting scientific development and integration of the community of young researchers at UKEN, contributing to strengthening position of the Doctoral both in in national as and international

Purpose and subject of the study

The aim of the study was to collect, organise and analyse data on the scientific activity of doctoral students. The study aimed to obtain an up-to-date picture of doctoral students' involvement in scientific and popularisation activities, as well as to identify areas that require further institutional support.

In particular, the study focused on the following aspects:

- Participation in national and international conferences – the extent of doctoral students' involvement in scientific life was examined by presenting the results of their research at scientific events, both in Poland and abroad (including international conferences organised in Poland).
- Awards, scholarships and distinctions received – information was collected on the individual successes of doctoral students, confirming the quality of their research and its recognition by external institutions (e.g. foundations, scientific associations, governmental and non-governmental organisations).

The collected data will be used to diagnose the level of scientific activity of doctoral students, identify good practices and possible barriers to the scientific career development of young researchers. The results of the study may serve as a basis for planning support measures and developing policies for the development of an academic environment friendly to young scientists.

Methodology

The study was conducted using quantitative methodology aimed at obtaining objective and comparable data on the scientific activity of doctoral students. The approach used allowed the phenomenon to be captured statistically, enabling the analysis of the frequency of individual activities and the identification of selected trends in the study population.

The study was quantitative in nature. It was designed to enable collect data that could then be subjected to statistical analysis.

A standardised online questionnaire was used as a tool, made available to participants via an electronic form. The questionnaire contained both closed single-choice questions and open questions allowing for more detailed answers and descriptions of specific scientific achievements.

The study involved 111 doctoral students representing various academic disciplines and stages of doctoral studies. The sample included individuals actively participating in the academic community within the UKEN Doctoral School in Krakow.

Purposeful sampling based on availability was used – the survey was sent to all persons meeting the study criteria, and participation was voluntary. Despite the lack of complete randomness, the number of responses obtained allows for reliable conclusions to be drawn about the study group.

Data collection took place between 2 July and 8 July 2025. During this time, respondents were given the opportunity to complete the online form at a time convenient for them. The entire process was anonymous, ethical and in accordance with applicable data protection regulations.

Presentation of results

The number of conferences broken down by number of participants is as follows

- Participation in 1 conference: 22 persons
- Participation in 2 conferences: 14 persons
- Participation in 3 conferences: 9 persons
- Participation in 4 conferences: 6 persons Participation in 5 or more conferences: 8 persons, including, for example, Rafał Barański (5 presentations), Ewa Durek (5), Karol Kordas (6), Katarzyna Panek (7), Karolina Dymek (5), Jadwiga Prażak (5).

In total, 59 people and 155 presentations were recorded. 52 people did not participate in national conferences.

The conferences were held at many academic centres throughout Poland.

The most frequently represented cities were:

- Krakow – UKEN, Jagiellonian University, Pontifical University, Home Army Museum (most events)
- Warsaw – University of Warsaw, Cardinal Stefan Wyszyński University, Polish Academy of Sciences Institutes, Eryda Foundation
- Lublin – Maria Curie-Skłodowska University, Centre for American Studies
- Gdańsk, Łódź, Poznań, Wrocław, Rzeszów, Katowice, Nowy Sącz, Zielona Góra, Częstochowa, Kielnarowa, Białystok, Zuzbrzyca Górna, Ryn and others

In some cases, conferences were organised in cooperation between universities or as interdisciplinary events. The vast majority of events, especially in 2023–2025, were stationary (e.g. Krakow, Warsaw, Gdańsk, Opole). Remote participation was recorded in 10 cases, e.g. MKDUS 2.0, TYGIEL, Congresses of Exact and Social Sciences. Hybrid: single events (e.g. part of speech therapy and technology conferences) where speakers connected remotely and some participants were physically present.

The thematic scope of the presentations was very broad and included:

- humanities (literature, history, linguistics),
- social sciences (social policy, social work, security, migration),
- natural and exact sciences (biology, engineering, mathematics),
- digital technologies, AI, deepfake, heritage protection,
- special education and inclusive education,
- art and aesthetics (photography, film, theatre),
- mental health, autism, speech therapy, neuropsychology.

Doctoral students of the UKEN Doctoral School in Krakow actively participate in the scientific life of the country, presenting their research at numerous national conferences.

Their presence covers almost all scientific disciplines and many renowned academic centres. This participation fosters interdisciplinary cooperation, integration of the young scientist community and promotion of UKEN's scientific achievements nationwide.

During the analysed period, 49 doctoral students of the Doctoral School of the UKEN participated in a total of 113 international scientific conferences. The distribution of the number of participations is as follows:

- 1 conference – 24 doctoral students,
- 2 conferences – 8 doctoral students,
- 3 conferences – 10 doctoral students,
- 4 conferences – 4 doctoral students,
- 5 or more conferences – 3 doctoral students (record holder – 9 conferences)

This distribution indicates the high scientific activity of the selected group of doctoral students, with a broad group participating in at least one event.

UKEN doctoral students presented their research findings in the following countries (number of events in brackets): Poland (77), Bulgaria (7), Germany (4), Great Britain (3), Russia, Ukraine, Lithuania, Slovakia, Czech Republic (2 each), Armenia, Georgia, Finland, Canada, Spain, Taiwan, USA, Kosovo, Albania, Japan, Portugal, Hungary (1 each). This impressive geographical spread demonstrates not only the international reach but also the cultural and thematic diversity of the research carried out by UKEN doctoral students.

Three basic forms of conference organisation were identified:

- Stationary – 79 conferences (69.5%)
- Online – 22 conferences (19.7%),
- Hybrid – 12 conferences (10.7%).

The classic stationary form dominates and, despite the pandemic-induced boom in hybrid formats, remains the preferred space for scientific exchange. Remote formats, on the other hand, increase accessibility for people with mobility or financial constraints.

The conferences covered a wide range of fields: research on politics, war, security, language, cultural identity, transformations in education, teacher competences, digitisation of education, neurobiology, environmental protection, artificial intelligence, textile art, and cultural memory.

The UKEN Doctoral School boasts significant international involvement of its doctoral students. Their presence at prestigious scientific events not only promotes the University but also builds a lasting network of international contacts.

A detailed list of other scientific achievements is presented in Table 3.

Doctoral students of the Doctoral School of the UKEN in Krakow are active in scientific and social activities, which is reflected in numerous prestigious scholarships, research grants, international scientific trips, and artistic and social awards.

Doctoral students have received prestigious scholarships, including:

- Scholarships from the Brzezia Lanckoroński Foundation (London) – awarded to K. Bednarek, M. Łękawska, K. Kordas and W. Zarębczan, among others, in recognition of their research in the humanities and social sciences.
- Government and university scholarships: e.g. *France Excellence Doctoral Cotutelle Scholarship* (N. M. Tran), *Sri Swami Haridas Giri Scholarship* (S. Bhattacharya), DAAD and NAWA scholarships (including G. Pieszko, D. Trojanowska, K. Rajkowski, I. Wiśniowska).

- Erasmus+ and Ceepus programmes – completed internships and foreign exchanges (including B. Krasniqi, I. Wiśniowska, D. Kadłub), enriching the research experience of doctoral students. Doctoral students actively participate in research projects, both as leaders and team members:
- NCN Sonata Bis Grant – A. Bramboszcz as a doctoral student in the grant team.
- NAWA STER projects – including D. Trojanowska, who is implementing a project on UN disarmament policy at the Permanent Mission of the Republic of Poland to the UN in Geneva. Some doctoral students were honoured for their social and artistic activities:
- Kasper Bednarek – state awards for patriotic activity and historical memory (including the Medal of the Guardian of National Remembrance Sites).
- Magdalena Hueckel-Śliwińska – Spektrum Pomorza 2025 award for artistic courage (Sopot Film Festival).
- Michał Tokarz-Mazurek and Paulina Tokarz-Mazurek – cultural scholarships and artistic awards, including first place at the Krosno Art Biennale and a nomination for the Żurawie Award.
- Karol Kordas – Honorary Badge of the Society of Friends of Lviv and the South-Eastern Borderlands.

Doctoral students have completed internships, exchanges and professional placements at foreign institutions (Germany, Great Britain, France, Cyprus, Slovakia, North Macedonia), which demonstrates their commitment to the internationalisation of research and the development of research and cultural competences.

The achievements accumulated to date testify to the high level of activity and commitment of UKEN doctoral students to scientific and artistic development, international cooperation and activities for the benefit of society. The diversity of areas – from humanities and social sciences, through natural sciences, to artistic activities – emphasises the interdisciplinary nature of the UKEN Doctoral School and its significant contribution to the development of the academic environment in Poland and abroad.

Analysis of results

Of the total number of 111 doctoral students surveyed: 59 (53.15%) participated in at least one national conference, 52 (46.85%) did not participate in any national conference. The distribution of the number of conferences per person is as follows: 1 conference – 22 people (37.29% of participants), 2 conferences – 14 people (23.73%), 3 conferences – 9 people (15.25%), 4 conferences – 6 people (10.17%), 5 and more conferences – 8 people (13.56%). The total number of presentations was 155 national conferences. The average number of conferences per person among active doctoral students was 2.63. Although almost half of the doctoral students did not participate in national conferences, there is a visible group of active participants who attended multiple conferences, which indicates an uneven distribution of involvement. This may be due to differences in disciplines, research topics, supervisor support or financial availability.

Forty-nine doctoral students participated in international events, which accounts for 44.14% of the total number of respondents. A total of 113 international presentations were recorded. The distribution of participation is as follows: 1 conference – 24 people (48.98% of active doctoral students), 2 conferences – 8 people (16.33%), 3 conferences – 10 persons (20.41%), 4 conferences – 4 persons (8.16%), 5 and more – 3 persons (6.12%), including one record holder – 9 conferences. The average number of international conferences per person is 2.31. As in the case of national events, activity is concentrated around a smaller group. However, international participation indicates high mobility and internationalisation of part of the doctoral student community.

National conferences: held at various academic centres, mainly in Krakow (UKEN, Jagiellonian University, Pontifical University of John Paul II) and Warsaw (University of Warsaw, Cardinal Stefan Wyszyński University, Polish Academy of Sciences). Other frequently represented cities included Lublin, Gdańsk, Poznań and Katowice. International conferences: these covered 23 countries, including Bulgaria, Germany, Great Britain, the USA, Japan, Taiwan and Canada. The largest number of presentations took place in Poland (77), which may indicate participation in international conferences held in the country. The wide geographical range indicates a high level of integration of doctoral students into the international scientific community, while maintaining strong local roots.

Despite the development of remote forms during the pandemic, stationary conferences remain the preferred form of scientific contact. Remote and hybrid forms increase accessibility, especially for people with health or financial limitations.

Participation in conferences confirms the interdisciplinary profile of the UKEN Doctoral School and indicates a strong representation of both classical sciences and modern technologies and applied fields.

Conferences are only one aspect of our activities. Data indicate that doctoral students are widely involved in academic and public life, which fosters their comprehensive development through participation in research projects (NCN, NAWA), obtaining prestigious national and international scholarships (DAAD, NAWA, Erasmus+), and awards for scientific, artistic and social activities.

Doctoral students at the UKEN Doctoral School demonstrate a high level of scientific activity, particularly in terms of participation in national and international conferences. There is a strong interdisciplinary representation and a dynamic entry into the international arena. At the same time, there are noticeable inequalities in participation, which are worth analysing in the context of access to funding, research topics and individual support from supervisors.

Conclusions and recommendations

The analysis of data on the participation of UKEN Doctoral School doctoral students in scientific events in recent years showed a high, albeit uneven, level of scientific activity in terms of participation in national and international conferences.

Out of 111 respondents, 59 people (53.15%) participated in at least one national conference, while 52 people (46.85%) did not participate in any such event. In the case of international conferences, this activity was slightly lower – 49 doctoral students declared their participation, which accounts for 44.14% of the total number of respondents. Although the average number of conferences per person among participants is relatively high (2.63 for national conferences and 2.31 for international conferences), it is worth noting that these figures are significantly inflated by a smaller, exceptionally active group of doctoral students. Some of the respondents participated in one or two conferences, while others reported five or more presentations, including one case of nine international conferences.

This distribution of activity indicates that scientific activity is concentrated in the hands of a limited number of people and may be the result of unequal access to resources: financial, promotional, linguistic and those resulting from the specific nature of the research conducted. There is a clear need for further diagnosis of the causes of this imbalance.

National conferences were held at renowned academic centres, primarily in Krakow (UKEN, UJ, UPJPII), Warsaw (UW, UKSW, PAN), as well as in Lublin, Gdańsk, Poznań, Katowice and other academic cities. International events covered as many as 23 countries, which proves the dynamic internationalisation of doctoral students' activities and their ability to present their research results in different cultural and linguistic contexts. Importantly, some of the international conferences took place in Poland, which may suggest the effective use of available opportunities to present research without the need to travel abroad.

According to , in terms of organisational form, , the most common were conferences stationary (approx. 70% of events), which indicates that the traditional form of face-to-face meetings remains the preferred model of scientific communication. Nevertheless, the development of online and hybrid events – especially after the pandemic – increases accessibility and may constitute

an important alternative for people with financial, health
logistical constraints.

The thematic scope of the UKEN doctoral students' presentations was very broad and covered both classical fields of the humanities and social sciences (literary studies, social policy, history) as well as issues in the fields of exact sciences, natural sciences, digital technologies, pedagogy, mental health and the arts. Such a broad range of research interests confirms the interdisciplinary nature of the UKEN Doctoral School and its ability to integrate scientific communities from various fields.

It is worth noting that conferences are only one aspect of doctoral students' activities. The respondents also demonstrated a high level of involvement in research projects (NCN, NAWA), obtaining prestigious international scholarships (DAAD, Erasmus+, NAWA) and winning awards artistic, social and scientific. These additional forms of activity confirm that the UKEN doctoral community is developing not only scientifically, but also culturally and civically, building a strong position for the University on the national and international map.

Recommendations for the further development of the UKEN Doctoral School

1. **Increasing the accessibility of conferences for a wide range of doctoral students.** In order to reduce inequalities in access to conferences, it is worth considering the creation of financial support programmes (e.g. internal microgrants to cover conference fees, travel and accommodation costs). Less expensive forms of participation should also be promoted (remote and national events of high prestige).
2. **Development of mentoring and promotional programmes.** The task for the Interdisciplinary Doctoral Student Research Club "InterScientia" is to implement tutoring and peer mentoring programmes, within which more experienced doctoral students could support those just starting their academic career. This support may include, among other things, assistance in preparing abstracts, selecting appropriate events or developing presentations.
3. **Active monitoring of barriers and differences in activity.** It is recommended to regularly monitor the scientific activity of doctoral students and identify barriers limiting participation (e.g. lack of funds, language difficulties, resistance to public speaking). On this basis, interventions tailored to the real needs of doctoral students can be designed.
4. **Strengthening the internationalisation of research.** The school should continue and intensify activities supporting participation in international events. This applies not only to funding, but also to language training, promoting

scholarship programmes and supporting participation in cotutelle and international research projects.

5. **Systematic promotion of good practices.** It is worth creating a platform (e.g. intranet or newsletter) where doctoral students could share their experiences of participating in conferences, recommend valuable events and share materials. It would also be good practice to organise internal post-conference presentations to disseminate knowledge and integrate the community.
6. **Strengthening the identity of the interdisciplinary nature of the School** . Participation in events combining different scientific fields should be supported, and interdisciplinary doctoral conferences should be organised independently, hosted by UKEN. Such activities foster community integration and promote the School as a centre of modern, open science.
7. **Increasing the visibility of doctoral students' achievements.** The data collected on conference and grant activity should be used not only for evaluation purposes, but also – both within the university and externally, e.g. through social media, annual reports and recruitment promotional materials.

The UKEN Doctoral School boasts a high level of scientific activity among its doctoral students. At the same time, the results of the analysis indicate a need to further support less active participants, equalise opportunities and promote a culture of cooperation. The implementation of the above recommendations may strengthen the scientific and integrative potential of the School and increase its recognition in Poland and abroad.
